Keith Patterson- Budget, 5.2 Million, Spent 10 Million, All spending. Probation was 1.1 million. Budget for this year is not out yet.

Field should address 4 things with Mental Health agency. Met with Local health and discussed issues and reported back to RM and provided responses. Communication was an issue, misunderstanding of services, Very pleased to find the level of communication and communication that we have.

QSR – Our region has been very represented in the QSR process. Region 17 pulls their weight in the process. Each region has to send two people to each QSR. Region 17 QSR is in November, Orientation is September

Jason Nelson- 4 proposals all were approved. Youth Villages add 3 tier. Other Homebased services were added. Scoring teams were Dale Stroud, Amy Temple, and Jessica Richardson. Services may start as soon as October. Modify Youth Villages. Motion carries.
