**2) Effect that approval of the controlled project would have on the political subdivision's tax rate**

This project will have a maximum debt service tax rate increase of \$0.1914 beginning in 2011. There is expected to be no additional impact on any other tax rates of the School Corp. See Exhibit A.

**3) Maximum term of the bonds or lease**

The maximum term of the bonds will be 20 years and the maximum term of the lease will be 22 years.

**4) Maximum principal amount of the bonds or the maximum lease rental for the lease**

The maximum annual lease rental will be \$6,525,000. See Exhibit A.

**5) Estimated interest rates that will be paid and the total interest costs associated with the bonds or lease**

The estimated interest rate assumed in preparing the impact from this project is approximately 5.75%. The estimated total interest cost is expected to be approximately \$46,000,000.

**6) Purpose of the bonds or lease**

The Bonds will finance projects at various school facilities for Noblesville Schools. See Exhibit B which includes a description of each of the nine projects.
