RE: Assessment Rate of Classified Forests, Windbreaks, & Filter Strips

Date: December 30, 2022

The assessment rate per acre of land classified as native forest land, a forest plantation, or wildlands under Ind. Code § 6-1.1-6-14; as a windbreak under Ind. Code § 6-1.1-6.2-9; or as a filter strip under Ind. Code § 6-1.1-6.7-9 is determined by multiplying the assessment rate for the preceding assessment year by one (1) plus the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers published by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics for the calendar year preceding the calendar year before the assessment date.

For the assessment date of January 1, 2023, the assessment rate for classified lands is calculated as follows:

X 1.07

Rate for the preceding assessment year (1-1-2022) \$14.63

Times the sum of one (1) plus the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for calendar year

2021. (1 + .07 = 1.07)

Assessment rate for classified lands for the \$15.65

assessment date of January 1, 2023

The Department will publish subsequent rates annually.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX – DECEMBER 2021

The Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 0.5 percent in December on a seasonally adjusted basis after rising 0.8 percent in November, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Over the last 12 months, the all items index increased 7.0 percent before seasonal adjustment.
