CRAWFORDSVILLE COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION

Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-20-3.6(k), a political subdivision for which a public question regarding a controlled project is to be placed on the ballot to be voted on at a public question, must submit to the Department of Local Government Finance ("Department"), at least thirty (30) days before the election, the below information regarding the proposed controlled project for posting on the Department's Internet Web site.

1. The name of the political subdivision and the county in which it levies a property tax.

Crawfordsville Community School Corporation, Montgomery County

2. The cost per square foot of any buildings being constructed as part of the controlled project.

The Tuttle Middle School project includes demolition of most of the existing building, remodeling of 9,912 remaining square feet, and new construction of 163,807 square feet. Cost per square foot is estimated at \$157.57.

3. The effect that approval of the controlled project would have on the political subdivision's property tax rate.

The estimated effect of the new debt on the School Corporation's property tax rate is \$.6584 per \$100 of assessed valuation, all in the Debt Service Fund, beginning in 2013.

4. The maximum term of the bonds or lease.

The maximum term of the bonds to be issued to finance the project is twenty (20) years. The maximum term of the lease is twenty-two (22) years.

5. The maximum principal amount of the bonds or the maximum lease rental for the lease.

The maximum principal amount of the bonds to be issued is \$35,000,000. The maximum annual lease rental is \$2,740,000.

6. The estimated interest rates that will be paid and the total interest costs associated with the bonds or lease.

The estimated interest rates range from 2% to 6%, average 4.375% and produce total interest costs of \$18,460,000.

7. The purpose of the bonds or lease.

The purpose is to provide financing for almost a totally new Tuttle Middle School to be constructed on the same site as the existing school. A small portion of the existing school will be retained with the rest being demolished.

The existing school was constructed in 1960 with very few improvements being made since. Mechanical systems, windows and the roof have gone beyond their useful lives.

- 8. In the case of a controlled project proposed by a school corporation:
 - (A) the current and proposed square footage of school building space per student:

The existing Middle School has 127,312 square feet of space of which all but 9,912 will be demolished. New construction of 163,807 square feet will make the total square footage 173,719 after the project is completed.

Present enrollment in the Middle School is 502 and the square footage per student is 254. After the project is completed, based on the same enrollment, square footage per student will be 346.
