The expansion project is nearly complete, with only the irrigation lines awaiting air testing. After confirming they are leak-free, the project will be ready for water. Additionally, the new columbarium is now operational and is housing four interments.

Next week, two state seals will adorn the front entrance. The vault area is ready and is projected to be operational in approximately 12 months. The roads have been paved, and curbs have been set. The Avenue of Flags is particularly impressive, especially at night when the flags are illuminated by the flagpoles.
