## SACC RFF 2023-009 Award Notice State School-Age Child Care Project Fund SFY 2024

Indiana's Office of Early Childhood and Out-of-School Learning (OECOSL) has awarded 38 grants to support school-age care through the State-funded School-Age Child Care (SACC) Project Fund for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2024. The 38 grantees represent 76 school-age child care sites in 24 Indiana counties (one applicant was evaluated across the three different counties they operate in, so they are listed three times in the table below leading to a total of 40 rows that are recommended for award). The grants total is \$1,539,907.22 for SFY 2024.
