Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* complex (including isolate submission)
- Positive Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) result

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report may be skipped if Report of Tuberculosis is completed and attached

Additional Documentation to Include

- Completed Report of Tuberculosis (State Form 10458)
- AFB results (Smear, NAAT, Culture)
- Radiography
- IGRA and/or TST
- Treatment information, including DOT records
