## Condition Name:

**Vibriosis (non-cholera),  
including *Grimontia* spp.**

## Condition Name in NBS:

**Vibriosis (non-cholera Vibrio species infections)**

## Reporting Timeframe:

**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- All species from the family *Vibrionaceae* (other than toxigenic *Vibrio cholerae*, which should be reported as Cholera), including isolates from a clinical specimen (all test types and specimen types)
- *Grimontia hollisae* species, including isolates from a clinical specimen
- *Photobacterium damsela* species, including isolates from a clinical specimen

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including water exposure, seafood consumption, and travel
