PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

On March 7, 2008, Complainant, Toniea Jones ("Jones"), filed her Agreed Motion To Dismiss, a motion to which Respondent – American Senior Communities, LLC d/b/a Spring Mill Meadows ("ASC") - has not responded.

Having carefully considered the foregoing and being duly advised in the premises the undersigned Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Indiana Civil Rights Commission ("ICRC") proposes that the ICRC enter the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jones' complaint alleges that, in November of 2004, she was unlawfully terminated from employment because of race. COMPLAINT OF DISCRIMINATION (February 03, 2005).

- 2. ASC disputes Jones' claim of unlawful discrimination. ANSWER (April 1, 2005).
- 3. Jones' Motion is expressly motivated by a settlement.
- 4. There is no evidence of fraud, coercion, duress, or any other reason not to approve the stipulated dismissal.
- 5. Any Conclusion Of Law that should have been deemed a Finding Of Fact is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The ICRC has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
- 2. Settlement is a favored resolution and should be encouraged.
- 3. Administrative review of this proposed decision may be obtained by the filing of a writing specifying with reasonable particularity each basis for each objection within 15 days after service of this proposed decision. IC 4-21.5-3-29(d).
- 4. Any Finding Of Fact that should have been deemed a Conclusion Of Law is hereby adopted as such.

ORDER

- 1. Jones' Agreed Motion To Dismiss is **GRANTED**.
- 2. Jones' complaint is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
