NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL

The Indiana Civil Rights Commission (Commission) has administratively dismissed the above referenced case, for the following reason: The parties have reached a settlement of the claims against Respondent and Complainant now asks that his complaint be withdrawn, with prejudice. There being no public interest that requires otherwise, this case is dismissed, with prejudice.

Complainant may appeal this Finding. 910 IAC 1-3-2 (2000). The written appeal request must be filed with the Indiana Civil Rights Commission within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this Notice of Finding and must include any new and additional evidence relied on by Complainant to support the appeal. Failure to submit a timely appeal may result in a waiver of any

right to further review or appeal of this Finding by the Commission or Indiana Courts. Upon the exhaustion of the administrative right to appeal, the complaint in this case is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

As this complaint was filed under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act, which is enforced by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC), Complainant has the right to ask the EEOC to review this action. To secure such a review, the request must be made in writing within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this Notice of Finding, and submitted to the EEOC, 101 West Ohio Street, Suite 1900, Indianapolis, IN 46204. Should Complainant fail to seek EEOC review, the EEOC will generally follow and
