PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

On May 28, 2014, Complainant, Erika Mireles, by counsel, and Respondent, Tequila Restaurante, by counsel, filed their JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS and WAIVER OF OBJECTION PERIOD ("Motion").

Having carefully considered the foregoing and being duly advised in the premises, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Indiana Civil Rights Commission ("ICRC") proposes that the ICRC enter the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. This proceeding involves a complaint of discrimination against Respondent alleging Respondent discriminated against Complainant on the basis of National Origin. (Complaint of Discrimination, June 20, 2012).
 - 2. The parties have reached a private settlement agreement.
 - 3. The parties are satisfied with the terms of the settlement agreement.
- 4. There is no evidence of fraud, coercion, duress, or any other reason not to approve of the requested dismissal.
 - 5. The parties waived the 15-day period for filing objections.

6. Any Conclusion of Law that should have been deemed a Finding of Fact is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The ICRC has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
- 2. Settlement is a favored resolution and should be encouraged.
- 3. Administrative review of this proposed decision may be obtained by the filing of a writing identifying with reasonable particularity each basis of each objection within fifteen (15) days after service of this proposed decision. IC 4-21.5-3-29(d).
- 4. The Parties waived the opportunity to present objections on this proposed decision.
- 5. Any Finding of Fact that should have been deemed a Conclusion of Law is hereby adopted as such.

ORDER

- 1. The parties' Joint Motion to Dismiss is **GRANTED**.
- 2. Erika Mireles' complaint is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
