care of his young daughter as well. So, I bring the Administrative Update, very briefly. A couple of -- well, one PC finding we did have that got some attention from the news media, which was -- involved a termination due to pregnancy at a restaurant-bar in Kokomo, Indiana,

so that will be scheduled for a hearing unless it

is settled in the meantime.

We are today holding our third CLE of the year in Columbus as we speak. Mike Healy is down there representing the Commission. We have another CLE next month. We'll be in Valparaiso, which is a town we haven't been in a while, so we're trying to reach out there and working with the County Bar Association and also the -- they have -- they don't have a local Commission by ordinance, but the Mayor's Office has a kind of a human relations council, so we're working with them.

And we have a pretty busy May, a lot of

education outreach things. The same goes for 1 June, a lot of Fair Housing training, and let's 2 3 see. Other news in the office, a couple of our summer interns are down here with us, and if you 4 5 want to introduce yourself, I haven't quite 6 learned your names yet. They just started this 7 week, so --8 MS. HARRIS: I'm Camille Harris. 9 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: What was that 10 again? 11 MS. HARRIS: Camille Harris. 12 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: Camille, 13 welcome. 14 MS. MILLER: I'm Abigail Miller. 15 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: Thank you. Welcome to you both. 16 17 MR. BREWSTER: They'll be here with 18 us through, I suppose, July or somewhere around 19 there --20 MS. HARRIS: (Nodded head yes.) 21 MR. BREWSTER: -- helping out with 22 investigations, intake, and also a little bit 23 with our attorneys, so -- and I think we are --

we have hired a replacement for one of our 2 investigators that left last month. I don't know when she starts, but probably in the next week or 3 4 so. So, we have now a full complement of 5 investigators, ten investigators. 6 So, that's about all I have to share. 7 questions? 8 (No response.) 9 MR. BREWSTER: All right. 10 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: All right. 11 Everything going all right, then, huh? 12 MR. BREWSTER: Yeah, going okay. 1.3 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: Okay. Well, 14 you have on the last page of your agenda the 15 listing of the meeting dates through to the end of the year. 16 17 Are there any announcements? 18 (No response.) 19 CHAIRPERSON BLACKBURN: Hearing 20 none -- oh, I want to share something. Since we 21 last met, I was invited to attend the 22 announcement of the winners of the Architectural
