PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

On July 10, 2008, Complainant Liza Garrett ("Garrett") and Respondent Bristol-Washington Township Public Library ("the Library") filed their Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice.

Having carefully considered the foregoing and being duly advised in the premises, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Indiana Civil Rights Commission ("ICRC") now proposes that the ICRC enter the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Garrett's complaint alleges that she was expelled and barred from the Library because of behavior that occurred during a seizure and that these actions were unlawful discrimination because of disability. COMPLAINT OF DISCRIMINATION (September 29, 2005) ("COMPLAINT").
- 2. The Library denied Garrett's claim of discrimination. NOTICE OF FINDING, page 2, ¶2 (December 4,2006).

- 3. The Stipulation is apparently motivated by a settlement.
- 4. There is no evidence of fraud, coercion, duress, or any other reason not to approve the stipulated dismissal.
- 5. Any Conclusion Of Law that should have been deemed a Finding Of Fact is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The ICRC has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
- Settlement is a favored resolution and should be encouraged.
- 3. Administrative review of this proposed decision may be obtained by the filing of a writing specifying with reasonable particularity each basis for each objection within fifteen (15) days after service of this proposed decision. IC 4-21.5-3-29(d).
- 4. Any Finding Of Fact that should have been deemed a Conclusion Of Law is hereby adopted as such.

<u>ORDER</u>

- The parties' Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice is GRANTED.
- Garrett's COMPLAINT is DISMISSED, with prejudice.
