MMSGGS will not be using subcontractors for purposes of fulfilling this solicitation. MMSGGS does not consider as subcontractors third party carriers or suppliers engaged for the purpose of providing delivery of products to MMSGGS's customers generally.

Except for the obligation to pay money, MMSGGS will not be liable to the other party for any failure or delay in performance caused by fires, shortage of materials or transportation, epidemics, government acts, acts of God, acts of terrorism, or any other matters beyond the MMSGGS's reasonable control, and such failure or delay will not constitute a material breach of this Agreement. Furthermore, MMSGGS is not a manufacturer of items and therefore is not able to prevent industry-standard supply chain issues such as manufacturer backorders, discontinuations, or allocations due to high demand or short supply.

MMSGGS does not have a published list price. For the purposes of this bid and the resulting Contract, MMSGGS requests defining the term, "list price" as MMSGGS' Internal (non-published) Government List Price which is a price for commercial items. Any discount offered in MMSGGS' proposal does not apply to Controlled Substances.

Controlled Substances may not be purchased through McKesson Medical-Surgical Government Solutions LLC (Tax ID #20-2046702). We have the option to subcontract these products through McKesson Medical-Surgical Inc. (Tax ID #94-2640465) upon approval of a controlled substance questionnaire and declaration as well as the opening of a controlled substance only account with McKesson Medical-Surgical Inc. If awarded, we will provide you with the link to complete the questionnaire and declaration. **NOTE: In order to continue purchasing controlled substances, Customers must maintain a balanced purchase portfolio between controlled substances and non-controlled substances (for example, Rx and Medical supplies).**

Please note that MMSGGS does not agree to fixed pricing on items for which a percent discount applies. Government List Price can vary as MMSGGS is not a manufacturer of items and therefore cannot control the cost of items.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

MMSGGS does not agree to the **first sentence of Section 1.19 – Compliance Certification**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

Responses to this solicitation serve as a representation that the Respondent has no current or outstanding criminal, civil, or enforcement actions initiated by the State, and it agrees that it will immediately promptly notify the State of any such actions.

Also, in relation to **Section 1.19 – Compliance Certification**, please note the following:

MMSGs is part of McKesson Medical-Surgical Inc., which is part of an enterprise that distributes a broad range of medical and pharmaceutical products across the country. McKesson Corporation and its affiliates are subject to various lawsuits from time to time. McKesson Corporation reports all material litigation and government actions (including material actions that involve McKesson Medical-Surgical) in its annual reports and SEC filings.

MMSGs does not agree with the last sentence of **Section 1.26 – Conflict of Interest** and requests removal in its entirety. MMSGs cannot screen for this specific business conflict in our hiring practices.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 1.E. and 1.E.1. – Quality Assurance / Warranty**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

MMSGs MAKES NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WITH RESPECT TO ANY PRODUCTS OR SERVICES PROVIDED BY MMSGs INCLUDING THE WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR THE FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR USE OR PURPOSE. THE STATE SHALL LOOK TO THE MANUFACTURER OF PRODUCTS AND THE PROVIDER OF SERVICE FOR ANY WARRANTY THEREON. NO AGENT, EMPLOYEE, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF MMSGs HAS ANY AUTHORITY TO MAKE ANY AFFIRMATION, REPRESENTATION, OR WARRANTY CONCERNING PRODUCTS OR SERVICES NOT SET FORTH IN THE STATE CONTRACT.

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 4 – Access to Records**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

Contractor agrees that the State, upon reasonable notice to Contractor, during normal business hours, at the State's expense and no more than once per calendar year, will have the right to examine records of Contractor related to this Agreement solely to verify invoice data, until expiration of one (1) year after the final payment under this Agreement. Contractor will be responsible for establishing and maintaining records sufficient to document the costs associated with performance under the terms of this Agreement.

As a company policy, MMSGs cannot agree to **Section 6 – Assignment of Antitrust Claims** in its entirety and requests its removal from the State's terms and conditions.

As services will not be provided, MMSGs does not believe that **Section 13 – Continuity of Services** is applicable to the bid/resulting contract and requests removal in its entirety.

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 16.A. – Disputes**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

Should any disputes arise with respect to this Contract, the Contractor and the State agree to act immediately-promptly to resolve such disputes. Time is of the essence in the resolution of disputes.

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 16.C. – Disputes**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

If the parties are unable to resolve a contract dispute between them after good faith attempts to do so, a dissatisfied party shall submit the dispute to ~~the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Administration for resolution. The dissatisfied party shall give written notice to the Commissioner and the other party. The notice shall include: (1) a description of the disputed issues, (2) the efforts made to resolve the dispute, and (3) a proposed resolution. The Commissioner shall promptly issue a Notice setting out documents and materials to be submitted to the Commissioner in order to resolve the dispute; the Notice may also afford the parties the opportunity to make presentations and enter into further negotiations. Within thirty (30) business days of the conclusion of the final presentations, the Commissioner shall issue a written decision and furnish it to both parties. The Commissioner's decision shall be the final and conclusive administrative decision unless either party serves on the Commissioner and the other party, within ten (10) business days after receipt of the Commissioner's decision, a written request for reconsideration and modification of the written decision. If the Commissioner does not modify the written decision within thirty (30) business days, either party may take such other action helpful to resolving the dispute, including submitting the dispute to an Indiana court of competent jurisdiction. If the parties accept the Commissioner's decision, it may be memorialized as a written Amendment to this Contract if appropriate.~~

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 19 – Employment Option**, and requests removal in its entirety.

MMSGs does not believe that **Section 29 – Key Persons** is applicable to the resulting contract and requests removal in its entirety.

MMSGs does not believe that **Section 36 – Ownership of Documents and Material** is applicable to the resulting contract and requests removal in its entirety.

MMSGs does not agree to **Section 49 – Work Standards**, but will agree to the following proposed language:

The Contractor shall execute its responsibilities by following and applying at all times the highest professional and technical guidelines and standards. If the State becomes dissatisfied with the work

product of or the working relationship with those individuals assigned to work on this Contract, the State may ~~request in writing the replacement of any or all such individuals, and the Contractor shall grant such request.~~ discuss those concerns with Contractor and Contractor will work with the State for resolution.

MMSGGS reserves the right to negotiate the criteria and details within the **Performance Metrics in Exhibit D of the Professional Services Contract**, if awarded.

In addition to the State's Terms and Conditions, MMSGGS requests the addition of the following language:

Limitation of Liability

In no event will MMSGGS be liable to the State under, in connection with, or related to this solicitation for any indirect, incidental, special, punitive, or consequential damages whether or not MMSGGS is advised of the possibilities of those damages whether based on breach of contract, warranty, tort, product liability, or otherwise (including lost profits) from any cause.

MMSGGS does not agree to **Section 28 – Insurance on the Professional Services Contract**, but will agree to the following proposed changes:

Insurance.

A. The Contractor and its subcontractors (if any) shall secure and keep in force during the term of this Contract the following insurance coverages (if applicable) covering the Contractor for any and all claims of any nature which may in any manner arise out of or result from Contractor's performance under this Contract:

1. Commercial general liability, including contractual coverage, and products or completed operations coverage (if applicable), with minimum liability limits not less than ~~\$700,000 per person and \$5,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 annual aggregate. unless additional coverage is required by the State.~~ The State is to be included named as an additional insured on a primary, non-contributory basis for any liability arising directly or indirectly under or in connection with this Contract.
2. Automobile liability for owned, non-owned and hired autos with minimum liability limits not less than ~~\$700,000 per person and \$5,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 annual aggregate.~~ The State is to be included named as an additional insured on a primary, non-contributory basis.
3. ~~Errors and Omissions liability with minimum liability limits of \$1,000,000 per claim and in the aggregate. Coverage for the benefit of the State shall continue for a period of two (2) years after the date of service provided under this Contract.~~
4. ~~Fiduciary liability if the Contractor is responsible for the management and oversight of various employee benefit plans and programs such as pensions, profit sharing and savings, among others with limits no less than \$700,000 per cause of action and \$5,000,000 in the aggregate.~~
5. ~~Valuable Papers coverage, if applicable, with an Inland Marine Policy Insurance with limits sufficient to pay for the re-creation and reconstruction of such records.~~
6. ~~Surety or Fidelity Bond(s) if required by statute or by the agency.~~
- 7.3. Cyber Liability addressing risks associated with electronic transmissions, the internet, networks, and informational assets, and having limits of no less than \$1,0700,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 in the aggregate.

The Contractor shall provide proof of such insurance coverage by tendering to the undersigned State representative a certificate of insurance prior to the commencement of this Contract and proof of workers' compensation coverage meeting all statutory requirements of IC § 22-3-2. In addition, proof of an "all-states endorsement" covering claims occurring outside the State is required if any of the services provided under this Contract involve work outside of Indiana.

B. The Contractor's insurance coverage must meet the following additional requirements:

1. The insurer must have a certificate of authority or other appropriate authorization to operate in the state in which the policy was issued.
2. Any deductible or self-insured retention amount or other similar obligation under the insurance policies shall be the sole obligation of the Contractor.
3. The State will be defended, indemnified, and held harmless to the full extent of the insurance required in this agreement. any coverage actually secured by the Contractor in excess of the minimum requirements set forth above. The duty to indemnify the State under this Contract shall not be limited by the insurance required in this Contract.
4. The ~~insurance required in this~~ Contractor, ~~through a policy or endorsement(s), shall~~ endeavor to provide include a provision that the policy and endorsements may not be canceled or modified without thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the undersigned State agency before any cancellation, non-renewal or reduction in limits.
5. ~~The Contractor waives and agrees to require their insurer to waive their rights of subrogation against the State of Indiana.~~

C. Failure to provide insurance as required in this Contract may be deemed a material breach of contract entitling the State to immediately terminate this Contract. The Contractor shall furnish a certificate of insurance and all endorsements to the State before the commencement of this Contract.

In response to bid requirements, below is operational information which describes MMSGs's ability to service the State related to this opportunity.

MMSGs can respond to State inquiries within 24-48 hours and has the ability to set up multiple accounts with State agencies. However, if a new account set-up is needed, that process itself will likely take longer than 48 hours to complete.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL**Section 1.4.7 – Shipping and Delivery**

With a nationwide network of distribution centers strategically located to provide optimal service to customers in the continental United States, MMSGs offers fast, reliable delivery solutions up to five days per week, Monday through Friday, in low unit of measure for standard Products. MMSGs's delivery system makes use of company-operated vehicles, common carrier agreements and overnight express shipments to provide a totally responsive delivery capability. This schedule means customers are able to requisition and receive Products when they need them, staying within their supply budget while keeping vital products in stock.

Our distribution centers are available Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, to ship products. Orders received prior to the designated cut-off time will ship the same day or on the location's scheduled shipping day.

- Stocked items for orders shipping to State agencies received before 1 p.m. local distribution center time will ship the same day or on the location's scheduled shipped day.
- Emergency delivery may be possible if the location is within the scope of a local delivery service. MMSGs will work with the State to accommodate emergency order processing requests whenever possible. Order size and time of the day the request is received are factors used in determining if the request can be shipped after the standard cut-off time. The actual price of local delivery is based on a number of factors, such as number of boxes, weight, and ship-to location. Customer service is available if a freight estimate is needed.

Standard delivery is Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Although a delivery time is not guaranteed, delivery for stock items generally occurs within 1-3 days & non-stock items occurs 2-4 weeks after receipt of order.

Returned Goods. Subject to applicable law, Seller will process returns in accordance with its Returned Goods Policy currently in effect, or as otherwise agreed to by Seller and Customer. Seller's current Return Good Policy is as follows:

- All requests for credits for Products must have a return authorization number issued by Seller's customer service department or Seller's automated customer service platform (e.g., McKesson SupplyManager™). Credit for Products not stocked in Seller's distribution center that are greater than \$500 require additional approval by Seller.
- Seller will issue a full credit for any Product returned due to Seller error (i.e. shipping error, damage in transit) or due to a recall or defective condition.
- The following Products are not eligible for a credit, unless the return is due to fault of Seller, recall, or defective condition: (i) special order Products; (ii) custom Products; (iii) Products identified as non-returnable in McKesson SupplyManager; (iv) Products not available for general or unrestricted distribution; (v) nonsellable Products. Nonsellable Products include, but are not limited to, Products that are open, damaged, past minimum expiration date for resell, cold chain, hazmat, controlled pharmaceuticals, or discontinued by the manufacturer, or that contain markings not made by Seller.
- Seller will issue a credit as follows for McKesson brand products: if returned within 180 days – Full amount; if returned after 180 days – No Credit. Non-consumable McKesson brand products must be sent back to Seller to be eligible for a credit, and are subject to inspection by Seller before credit is issued to Customer. Consumable McKesson brand products should not be sent back to Seller's distribution center.
- Seller will issue a credit as follows for all other eligible Products:
 - Products stocked in Seller's distribution center that are less than \$15: if returned within 180 days – Full amount; if returned after 180 days – No Credit
 - Products stocked in Seller's distribution center that are \$15 and greater: if returned within 30 days – Full amount; if returned between 30-180 days – Full amount, less a restocking fee; if returned after 180 days – No Credit
 - Products NOT stocked in any of Seller's distribution centers that are less than \$100 – No Credit
 - Products NOT stocked in any of Seller's distribution centers that are \$100 and greater: if returned within 180 days – Full amount, less Seller and vendor restocking fees; if returned after 180 days – No Credit
- Products stocked in a Seller distribution center that are \$15 and greater and Products NOT stocked in a Seller distribution center that are \$100 and greater must be sent back to Seller to be eligible for a credit, and are subject to inspection by Seller before credit is issued to Customer. All other Products should not be sent back to Seller's distribution center.

Section 1.4.9 – Reporting

SupplyManagerSM, our web-based ordering platform, is available to those who prefer an online ordering option. SupplyManager provides real-time information on the availability of products, as well as, order status information. SupplyManager includes features, such as, creating custom order lists, determining product usage, tracking 12-month trends and the ability to access reports with a click of a button.

SupplyManager supply ordering templates can be customized to your unique requirements to support formulary management, assist with utilization and help control supply spend.

Many reports are available through SupplyManagerSM; this allows the location to also customize the report to fit their unique needs. The reports are accessed using the Reports Tab and many can be exported to Microsoft[®] Excel.

Some examples are:

Section 1.B. – Restricted Items

MMSGGS product categories may not align identically with the State's product categories, and therefore it will be the responsibility of the State to determine what products/categories are "restricted" and submit orders pursuant to the resulting Contract. MMSGGS will not be liable for determining and/or accepting orders for "restricted" products/categories.

Section 1.D.6. – Customer Service Hours

MMSGGS Customer Service hours of operation are: 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (excluding holidays).

Section 1.D.7. – Customer Service Response Time

MMSGs's dedicated government customer service center will take ownership of issues within 48 hours; however, depending on the complexity of the situation, and if other departmental input is needed, it may take longer than 48 hours for complete resolution.

Section 1.F.1. – Hard Copy Catalog

MMSGs does not publish a catalog with pricing. SupplyManagerSM, our web-based ordering platform, is available to view customer specific pricing in place of an on-going electronic copy of the catalog. The online catalog is available to users with an MMSGs account number and a User ID / Password for SupplyManagerSM. The website is <https://mms.mckesson.com>. Once a State agency has an established account number with MMSGs, this account can be used to access the on-line catalog via SupplyManager.

Section 1.F.4. – Ways to Place an Order

MMSGs does not have a process for identifying “abnormal” orders. It will be the responsibility of the State to determine an “Authorized User” who is approved to make purchases and submit orders pursuant to the resulting Contract. MMSGs will not be liable for determining “Authorized Users” making purchases on behalf of the State.

Section 1.F.5. – Order Confirmation

An email order confirmation will be sent within 24 hours of receipt of Purchase Order.

Section 1.G.5. – eProcurement Third Party Management

MMSGs only provides a punchout catalog no other cXML catalog nor csv catalog data will be provided. All contractually required information submitted to the State of Indiana and the State-assigned third party contract managing firm must remain confidential.

Section 1.I.1. – Delivery Timeframes

Stocked items for orders shipping to State agencies received before 1 p.m. local distribution center time will ship the same day or on the location's scheduled shipped day. Although a delivery time is not guaranteed, delivery for stock items generally occurs within 1-3 days & non-stock items occurs 2-4 weeks after receipt of order.

Section 1.I.3. – Proof of Delivery

Proof of delivery information is available and can be requested for eighteen months from time of delivery.

Section 1.I.4. – Backorders

Backorder information may not be immediately available and included on order confirmation emails and will not be annotated on the packing list. When using SupplyManagerSM to place orders, the system will indicate if a product is in stock, on backorder, has limited quantities in stock or if the product is shipping from another distribution center. If a product is not available, the individual placing the order will be asked if they would like

to order a recommended substitute (if McKesson has been made aware of a substitute) or leave the item on back order.

If the item is backordered, our Inventory Management team monitors the situation to reduce delays in delivery. When possible, the item generally is routed to the next available distribution center and will ship from this alternate location. Customer service is also available to assist with backorder situations.

Section 1.I.5. – Product Substitutions

MMSGGS is not a manufacturer of products and therefore cannot guarantee replacement items will be provided at the same price; however, we will work with the State to identify a comparable alternative at a comparable price as product discontinuations are identified.

Section 1.J.1. – Billing/Payment – Invoice

A Purchase Order number displays on the packing list and invoice when it is applied during the order entry process. Upon request, more information can be provided regarding our order processing methods.

The State will be given a toll-free phone number which automatically routes the call to the next available individual within your dedicated team of customer service representatives. Customer service also has a toll-free fax number and email available if this is a preferred method of communication. This highly skilled customer service group is dedicated to serving the needs of our government customers and is available to handle all order fulfillment needs, such as:

- Help locate products
- Provide order status information
- Place orders
- Proof of delivery (only available for 18 months after date of order)

Delayed shipments are not indicated on the packing slip or via the order confirmation email. However, order status is available through our online ordering system or by calling our customer service department.

Lastly, issues reported are promptly resolved by our customer service department according to standard operating procedures and metrics to quickly and efficiently resolve complaints, disputes, and grievances. We will always take ownership of issues within 48 hours, but there may be times that we need to utilize other departments to help resolve the concern which may cause final resolution to fall outside of that timeframe. The Customer Service Supervisors help manage workflow, so calls are answered, and issues are handled timely. The Customer Service Supervisors are there to assist if an issue requires escalation. 


