Road Salt for INDOT, Other State Agencies, and Local Government Entities

Total Estimated Value of Awards: \$30,589,535.95

Based on the State's evaluation of bids received for ASA-17-088, Cargill Inc., Compass Minerals America, Inc., Detroit Salt Company LLC, and Morton Salt, Inc. are recommended for a split award to provide Road Salt for INDOT, Other State Agencies and Local Government Entities by the salt types, districts, and entities specified below. Cargill, Inc. claimed and qualified for the Indiana Business Preference, as well as the U.S. Manufactured Preference for all line items. Compass Minerals America, Inc. claimed and qualified for the U.S. Manufactured Preference for select line items bid. Detroit Salt Company LLC claimed and qualified for the U.S. Manufactured Preference for all line items bid. Morton Salt, Inc. claimed and qualified for the U.S. Manufactured Preference for select line items bid. Pricing preferences were applied to qualified bids and were included during price evaluation. Please refer to the attached .xls file, **Attachment A**, for detailed preference information by line item.

When necessary, the bidders were asked to clarify their responses in order to ensure State needs were met. The bids were evaluated by the Indiana Department of Administration according to the criteria established in the bid documents.

During the course of the evaluation, proposals were scrutinized to determine the viability of the proposed business solutions to meet the needs of the State.

The term of each initial contract shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date of contract execution. There may be three (3) one year renewals for a total of four (4) years at the State's option.
