RESOLUTION 35-23

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SOUTH BEND AND ELKHART/GOSHEN FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2024-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) (Public Law 117-58, also known as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law") designating joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration rules and regulations, under Section 134, Title 23 of the US Code, the act requires the annual preparation of a Transportation Improvement Program by the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization(s) as a part of the transportation planning process in urbanized areas of 50,000 or more population; and
- WHEREAS, the Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) being the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, in cooperation with local governmental units and implementing agencies within the urbanized areas, has prepared a FY 2024-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which consist of improvements recommended in the MACOG Region.
- WHEREAS, the FY 2024-2028 TIP is consistent with the 2050 Transportation Plan (TP) and its corresponding conformity determination, which uses the MACOG travel demand model, developed with the most recently available socio-economic and other input data to estimate mobile source emissions for the conformity analysis.
- WHEREAS, the MACOG Policy Board from time to time receives and amends/modifies its Transportation Improvement Program.
- WHEREAS, upon review of the amendments below, MACOG here within finds that they are consistent with the 2050 TP and its corresponding conformity analysis.
- BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen FY 2024-2028 TIP will be amended to include the following:

Thanks for the note below!

For the most part, moving phases/projects into, or out of, the federally eligible years of the TIP is an amendment (the exception has generally been in the case of adding phases for grouped projects). Once an old TIP is rendered void (at the time the new TIP is incorporated into the STIP) projects included in it can no longer be modified or amended.

I believe the INDOT STIP amendment/modification worksheet states something similar: "Please remember that when moving a project into the STIP from a year outside the current STIP, an amendment is required."
