| Justification                 | The proposed replacement bridge will be approximately 250 feet long, with 700 foot approaches. Bridge 51 carries Blackiston Mill Road over Silver Creek and currently serves as a critical link between the City of New Albany and the Town of Clarksville. The bridge structure itself is the responsibility of Floyd County, with the northern approach being in the City of New Albany and the southern approach in the Town of Clarksville and Clark County.
