

Dear Randy,

This is to inform you of the approval of an administrative modification to the 2012-2015 Indianapolis TIP. These projects are programmed in the current TIP without detail and thus this modification is intended to provide greater detail for these grants. The MPO concluded that the modification is air quality exempt, per 40 CFR 93.126 & 127, and there is no need to update the conformity analysis or issue a new conformity finding. The Air Quality Consultation Group has been provided a copy of this modification for informational purposes. The modification is listed below:
