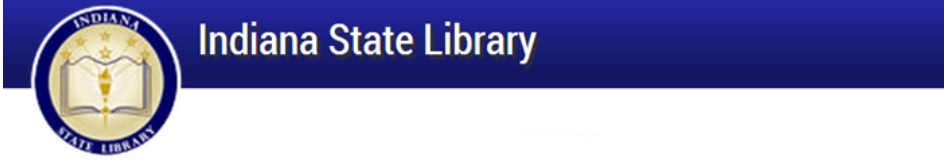

2020 Census DHC File

As you may know, the decennial census data release schedule was altered by COVID-19. The Census Bureau has released a fact sheet of [2020 Census Operational Adjustments](#) to detail the changes. In May, we received the most [recent release](#) of 2020 Census data, the Demographic Profile (DP) and Demographic and Housing Characteristics file (DHC). See the webpages for [DP](#) and [DHC](#) for descriptions of the of the data, along with technical documentation and guidance for use. Access the data using [Data.Census.gov](#). The Census Bureau has also released a special notice about the use of [Disclosure Avoidance and the 2020 Census Demographic and Housing Characteristics File](#). This notice mentions the [2020 Census Redistricting Noisy Measurement File](#) (NMF). The Indiana State Data Center will provide more information about the Census Bureau's methods of Disclosure Avoidance and how it impacts Indiana data in the coming months. Do you need Indiana data and maps for your projects? Need to know where to locate the right data? Or how to learn more about the data? [StatsIndiana](#) can help! The [StatsIndiana](#) website, maintained by the Indiana Business Research Center ([IBRC](#)) at Indiana University's [Kelley School of Business](#), has a directory of **Data by Topic** that will lead you to the correct Indiana data sources for your needs, whether local, state, or national. Each topic page has direct links to data and indicates its release as monthly, annually, or semi-annually. Each page describes how data are collected and contains data descriptions and tips for use. See the [Data Release Calendar](#) here. The IBRC has a little-known but highly helpful [Article Index](#), searchable by topic, which directs readers to publications inside and outside of the state. These include the [Indiana Business Review](#), [InContext](#), [USDA publications](#), Indiana University and Purdue University reports and projects, and more. The website also contains a Maps section where you'll find the most recent boundaries for geographic areas, legislative districts, and library & school districts. Check it out today!

One of the best services we provide at the State Data Center is our printing service for census maps. After each decennial census, tract and block maps are redrawn. We provide large format maps on demand, up to the size of a standard poster (24 in x 36 in), also known as A1 (23.4 in x 33.1 in).
